

2020 Term dates

Diploma in Youth and Community Work (Christian) (10707NAT)

- A two-year course (over 42 weeks each year). The intake of new student will start Monday 17th February and finish 4th December 2020.
- Dates for 2021 will be available during next year.
- Run in selected Fusion centres across Australia.
- Approx. 12 hours of lectures
- Approx. 5 hours of fieldwork per week, (including office work)

Term dates

The learning and training plan will be organized according to terms.

(Note: these dates may not align with term dates in some of the states of Australia)

Term 1 – 17th February to 3rd April

The first week of training from February 17th to 19th will be an Intensive 3 days of lectures.

Note: All students will be required to participate in the Pilgrimage to Uluru during the school holidays. Dates to be announced.

Holidays 3rd to 26th April

Term 2 – 27th April to 3rd July

Note: in term 2 there will be a 3 day intensive. *Date to be confirmed*

Holidays 3rd to 19th July

Term 3 – 20th July to 18th September

During this term Fusion Australia holds its annual conference which students are welcome to attend. The intensive for this term will be aligned with the dates for this conference in Tasmania.

Holidays 18th September to 4th October

Term 4 – 5th October to 4th December

Dates for 2021 will be added soon.

Fieldwork:

Each student will have a flexible fieldwork plan of approximately 5 hours a week. It could for example include 3 hour Talk 'n Tucker (faith discovery group) Tuesday night, 2 hours Lunch Times with a Difference (school lunch time program), Thursday and 3 hours pro-rata day trips on Saturdays once a month. The Pilgrimage to Uluru is also part of the fieldwork.
