

## 2020 Term dates

### Diploma of Youth and Community Work (Christian) (10707NAT)

- A two-year course (over 42 weeks each year), run in selected Fusion centres across Australia.
- Approx. 7 hours of formal lectures one day per week (Mondays)
- Integration and field work tutorials, spiritual disciplines another 3-4 hours per week
- Three intensives of 5 days each year. (Venues to be confirmed)
- Approx. 5 hours of fieldwork per week, (including office work)

**Term dates** *(Note: these dates may not align with term dates in some of the states of Australia)*

#### Term 1 – 10<sup>th</sup> February to 9<sup>th</sup> April

**Year 2 students start 10<sup>th</sup> February (Monday)**

**Year 1 students start 17<sup>th</sup> February (Monday)**

First intensive (both year 1 & 2) 24<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February (in Sydney)

*(Easter is 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> April 2019)*

**Note:** All students will be required to participate in the Pilgrimage to Uluru during the school holidays. **Dates: 12<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> April**

**Holidays 23<sup>rd</sup> April to 3<sup>rd</sup> May**

#### Term 2 – 4<sup>th</sup> May to 3<sup>rd</sup> July

Second intensive 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> May (in Victoria)

**Holidays 3<sup>rd</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> July**

#### Term 3 – 20<sup>th</sup> July to 18<sup>th</sup> September

Third intensive the week before Fusion's National Conference in Poatina, Tasmania  
6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> September

Conference: 11<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September (TBC)

**Holidays 18<sup>th</sup> September to 4<sup>th</sup> October**

#### Term 4 – 5<sup>th</sup> October to 4<sup>th</sup> December

**Graduation for second year students will be during the first week of December**

#### Fieldwork:

Each student will have a flexible fieldwork plan of approximately 5 hours a week. It could for example include 3 hour Talk 'n Tucker (faith discovery group) Tuesday night, 2 hours Lunch Times with a Difference (school lunch time program), Thursday and 3 hours pro-rata day trips on Saturdays once a month. The Pilgrimage to Uluru is also part of the fieldwork.
