



2019 Term dates

Diploma in Youth and Community Work (Christian) (10707NAT)

- A two-year course (over 42 weeks) starting 18th February and finishing 6th December.
- Over 4 terms for 2 years
- Run in selected Fusion centres across Australia.

- Approx. 12 hours of lectures
- Approx. 5 hours of fieldwork per week, (including office work)

Term dates

The learning and training plan will be organized according to terms.
(Note: these dates may not align with term dates in some of the states of Australia)

Term 1 – 18th February to 5th April

Orientation day: Monday 11th February

The first week of training from **February 18th to 20th** will be an Intensive 3 days of lectures.
(To be held at a central location – to be announced)

Note: All students will be required to participate in the Pilgrimage to Uluru from 7th to 17th April

Holidays 17th to 29th April

Term 2 – 29th April to 28th June

Note: in term 2 there will be a 3 day intensive. *Date to be confirmed*

Holidays 29th June to 14th July

Term 3 – 15th July to 20th September

Note: in early term 3 there will be an intensive week of lectures in a central location for all students. *Date to be confirmed.*

During this term Fusion Australia holds its annual conference which students are welcome to attend.

Holidays 20th September to 6th October

Term 4 – 7th October to 6th December

Dates for 2020 will be added soon.

Fieldwork:

Each student will have a flexible fieldwork plan of approximately 5 hours a week. It could for example include 3 hour Talk 'n Tucker (faith discovery group) Tuesday night, 2 hours Lunch Times with a Difference (school lunch time program), Thursday and 3 hours pro-rata day trips on Saturdays once a month. The Pilgrimage to Uluru is also part of the fieldwork.
